

# Sika Wonder Wipes

<b>Product Description</b>	Sika Wonder Wipes are specially formulated for the building and allied trades to clean wet and semi-cured paints, sealants, adhesives, bitumen's, polyurethanes, expanding foams, polyester fillers and epoxies from hands, tools and surfaces.
<b>Uses / Benefits</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Contain a powerful antibacterial additive which has been tested by an independent laboratory to BSEN 1276:2009 and PREN 12054:1995 – the standards for killing bacteria on dirty surfaces and hands.</li><li>• Is resistant to MRSA, salmonella, Listeria and E.Coli.</li><li>• Easily removes wet sealants &amp; adhesives, oil, grease petrol and inks, yet powerful cleaning agents are still kind to the hands.</li><li>• Available in 100 wipe packs.</li><li>• Removes finger marks, dirt, grime, oil, grease, petrol inks, food stains, part cured sealant and paint smears.</li></ul>
<b>Important Note</b>	On sensitive surfaces, Sika Wonder Wipes should be tested in an inconspicuous place to ensure no adverse effect occurs to the surface.
<b>Application Conditions / Limitations</b>	
<b>Application</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Pull off lid and open closure.</li><li>• Find the start wipe in the centre of the roll.</li><li>• Pull out approximately 300mm of wipes and thread through the lid.</li><li>• Replace lid immediately and reseal closure.</li><li>• Wipe on hand/spills, use immediately for the best results.</li></ul>
<b>Storage</b>	Store in cool dry conditions away from direct sunlight between 5° to 25°C. Storage outside these parameters will significantly reduce shelf life. Ensure good ventilation.
<b>Shelf Life</b>	36 months from date of manufacture
<b>Limitations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Do not use on porous surfaces such as untreated wood.</li><li>• Do not dispose of wipes in toilets.</li><li>• Use only as directed.</li><li>• Store only in original container</li><li>• As with all detergents, people with sensitive or damaged skin should avoid prolonged contact with skin.</li><li>• It is the user's responsibility to determine suitability for use. If in doubt contact technical services department for advice.</li></ul>
